

2016 Book Exchange

The annual Book Exchange will be held outside the library on Thursday, June 2nd for grades 3-5, and Friday, June 3rd for grades TK-2.

Bring your gently used books to the front of the library before school on your exchange day and receive a ticket for each book you bring. Then at morning recess, use your tickets to "buy" different books.

Returning this year!

- There will be color-coded tickets given out for each book you turn in.
 - o Blue tickets will be given for books that are aimed at preschool readers.
 - o Red tickets will be given for books that are aimed at TK-2nd grade readers.
 - White tickets will be given for books that are aimed at 3rd-5th grade readers.
- The parent volunteers, along with Mrs. Steele, will decide on the age level of each book.
- When it is time to "buy" your new books, the color of your ticket will be used to get a same level book (ie, if you have a white ticket, you may only get a book from the white ticket table)

Tips for a happy book exchange:

- Keep in mind this is a straight across trade, not a trade up.
- Gently used books for grades TK-5 only no magazines, coloring books, or books aimed for toddlers or teens/adults.
- Remember: all books paperback, hardcover, chapter books, and picture books are worth one ticket each.
- Please limit the number of books you bring to a maximum of 15 books/per person.
- Only bring the number of books that you are willing to take away from the exchange.
